- Actively participate in the fit-up and load-out alongside the freelance Production Staff
- Ensure the accurate and detailed completion of all production paperwork.
- Assist the Company Manager and Stage Management department during the fitup and load out.

- Ability to remain calm under pressure
- Demonstrate strong problem-solving skills in a fast-paced, live production environment is essential.
